### FAQs: Camping/Off-site at VISO

#### **Who can camp?**

Parents and guardians are most welcome to have their children camping with them on Friday and Saturday nights. Please see the House parents in person as early as possible for agreement for your child to camp with you, as a statement from the student alone will not be sufficient. Please confirm your intention to camp by signing the form at the Main Gate and be aware of the camping fee of KSh 900 per family per night. You will be issued with a 'Pass' for entry to the camping area.

#### **When can I collect students to camp?**

On Friday afternoon, Senior School students can be collected from 4.30 pm from Boarding Houses. Prep School pupils can be collected from at 3.00pm from Boarding Houses. Please note that once children have been signed out of Boarding Houses, they must stay with parents or guardians overnight and cannot return to their Boarding Houses later in the evening to sleep.

#### **Who should I tell?**

In addition to filling in brief details at the Main Gate, you must see House parents or Matrons and let them know who you are taking out to camp and where you are camping. A sign out list should also be signed in the Boarding House. Please speak to House parents when collecting students. Students may take their duvet for camping, but not pillows.

#### **Can other students camp with us?**

If a family is prepared for their son/daughter to camp with another family, including relatives, the parent(s) must contact the School to say that they agree to their son/daughter camping with another family. The 'receiving' family must also contact the School to agree to this happening and, in so doing, accept responsibility for the additional student.

#### **Can I sleep off-site?**

Parents and guardians may take their children off site, but only with the permission of their House parents. If this is the case, the student must return to School for roll call for Chapel at 10:00am on Sunday. If a student is returning to School after a day trip, he/ she must do so by 7:00pm. Please ensure that students are well behaved and monitored while off-site. Families may take only 2 additional students with them and this must be by prior arrangement, with both the 'taking' and 'receiving' parents giving permission to the School. All students must be properly supervised whilst off-site, so as to maintain the good reputation of St Andrew's.
